Ad-hoc minor roads urgent maintenance contract April 2022 to March 2023

Applications are invited to tender for this contract:

To provide ad-hoc additional urgent maintenance support to complement the Council's regular lengthsman contract. Including:

- Small tree and branch removal from the public highways. Will require platform to work at height.
- Emergency snow clearance from short sections of road.
- Storage of salt and emergency refilling of salt bins
- Emergency salt spreading (tow along spreader provided)
- Removal of soil from the roadway after flooding etc to include road sweeping.
- Removal and disposal of fly-tipping on the public highway
- Storage and delivery of sandbags to premises at risk of flooding
- Other tasks as reasonably expected

The contractor will need to be available at short notice any day at reasonable time to perform tasks as the purpose of this contract is to provide urgent support for the parish's Unclassified & C class minor roads network.

Applications should confirm which sections of the contract requirements can be met with a brief summary of the equipment and personnel, available days/hours and expected call out time.

Applications should quote an hourly rate for machinery and labour with breakdown for additional machinery, personnel and service if needed.

The work is occasional and there is no guaranteed minimum quantity of work.

Contractor needs to provide own tools, equipment and PPE to appropriate Health & Safety standards for working in the public highway.

Contractor will need to provide evidence of suitable public liability insurance, training certificates etc.

The contract decision will be based on multiple factors including cost, availability, local knowledge, equipment available. Decision to be advised by 21st February 2022
