New Speed Indicators at Accident Hotspot

Ballingham Bolstone & Hentland Parish Council have installed two traffic speed indicators (SIDs) at St Owens Cross to remind motorists of their speed in the 40MPH limit at the dangerous crossroads on the A4137. The SIDs display the vehicle's speed but also record every detection which can be downloaded and provided to the Police to aid speed limit enforcement.

Parish Council Chairman, Martin Soble said "We have campaigned for speed control through the village and grateful that a grant of almost £9,000 from the West Mercia Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner enabled us to install these devices. We hope that drivers will notice if they are speeding and slow down".

The grant application was prepared by Councillor Nat Thomas who also set up the devices and will manage the downloaded data.
